We are delighted that the London Summer Arbitration School 2026 will soon start in hybrid format. We would like to provide you with some additional information related to the summer school.

- **Teaching platform:** You can access our teaching platform under the following [link](#). On this platform, which will regularly be updated, you will find:
  - the most recent version of the **programme** of the school providing you an overview about the course content and optional social activities;
  - the **Zoom logins** for our online participants (please note that there is a login for all classes, and two separate logins for the [opening keynote](#) and the [closing keynote](#)). Please register for keynotes to get links if you attend online. No need to register separately for keynotes if you attend in person;
  - **practical information**, notably about the places where the school is hosted, lunch options, etc;
  - all the **teaching materials** (reading assignments, legal instruments, guiding questions); please note that this section is still under construction as we expect additional materials from faculty members.

  - **Reading assignments:** Please note that for most classes you will need to read materials in advance. We expect that all reading materials will be on the platform about a week before the beginning of the summer school.
  - **Reflective journal:** On the first day of the school, we will explain what the reflective journal is and how to approach it; the template for the reflective journal will be available as soon as the school starts.
